<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Embalming is the process of replacing blood and bodily fluids with chemical preservatives. It is a process of sanitation, restoration and temporary preservation. Embalming is not legally required, but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and the visitation or disposition of the deceased. Our professional funeral directors will make a recommendation based on the condition of the body and expected service needs. (maximum of 3 hours) • In some circumstances, additional restorative efforts beyond those captured in the standard embalming procedure are necessary to enhance the appearance of the deceased. Removal of pacemaker or implant

- The removal of a pacemaker or implant to be carried out by a licensed professional and disposed of in accordance with present regulations. \$150.00

Equipment for services at a remote location

- Deliver, set up and use of equipment necessary for services at a location other than the funeral establishment. \$595.00

Refundable Deposit for Cremated Remains

- When human remains are to be cremated, a refundable deposit will be required to be paid. If the cremated remains are not claimed within one year of the cremation, the deposit may be used to inter the cremated remains in common ground. If the cremated remains are claimed before they are interred, the deposit will be refunded \$350.00

Weekend/Holiday Service Charge

- Memorial or Funeral services occurring more than three days after the date of death and taking place on a Saturday, Sunday or Statutory Holiday will be subject to an extra fee. \$350.00

Attendance only for Interment of cremated remains

- Monday-Friday attendance for interment at cemetery \$195.00
- Saturday, Sunday or Holiday attendance for interment at cemetery \$395.00

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Attendance for Spring Interment

- Licensed funeral staff to attend and oversee a spring interment, when family will be present for a graveside committal service and/or prayers. \$195.00
- **Weekend** service charges will apply if held on a Saturday, Sunday or holiday \$395.00

Medical Retrieval

- If Medical Certificate of death is not present with body at time of death, staff to retrieve within 30 kms., or additional mileage will apply \$ 50.00

Disbursements

Disbursements are items arranged for, and possibly paid for on your behalf to other Providers, by the funeral home. You are expected to pay for these items at the time the contract is entered into. The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements:

Cemetery fees – these are the fees charges by a cemetery to complete opening and closing of a grave and other related fees as outlined by each cemetery’s bylaws.

Coroner’s fee – this is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario.

Clergy honorarium – this is an amount paid to the clergy for their services. In some cases the amount is set by the clergy, in others it is an amount to be determined by you.

Organist- this is an amount paid to the organist for their services. In some cases the amount is set by the organist, in others it is an amount to be determined by you.

Newspaper or radio notices – these are charges for death notices placed in newspapers or radio or other media outlets.

Municipal death registration fee – this is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality and may vary.

Bereavement Authority of Ontario Consumer Protection Fee – this is a fee charged by the Ontario licensing body for each death registered by a funeral home in order to maintain operations solely for the protection of consumers.

Payment

Unless otherwise specified, payment is due within 30 days of signing the contract. Payment may be made by cash or cheque. Beyond the allotted time, interest will be charged at a rate of 2% per month which is equivalent to 26.82% per annum (APR).

Funding

For your convenience, we offer options of prepaying services or supplies. When prepaying, you pay for the services and supplies today and the money will be used to pay for the services and supplies when they are delivered at the time of death.

Insurance: Payment is made directly to the insurance company, according to the value of your prepaid contract. The funeral home has a program with an Insurance company, your money will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered) or the contract is cancelled.
